## Letter from the Board President

2012 was an historic year for the Fort Collins Museum of Art. It began with the triumphant opening of the exhibition *Chibuly Venetians: From the George R. Stroemple Collection* that drew record crowds to the museum. The opening also was a testament to the hard work of the FCMOA board, staff and volunteer force who worked many long hours to repair and renovate the interior of the museum's national historic register facility after it suffered major water damage in 2011. As you will see in the attached financials, that damage resulted in a modest operating deficit for FY 2012.



As thousands of visitors walked through our galleries in 2012, the museum board was hard at work exploring all options to address the infrastructure and building issues of its century-old facility. 2012 will now go on record as the year the museum was able to address those issues through a purchase agreement with Brinkman Partners by which FCMOA would own its main floor gallery and offices and Brinkman would own and manage the rest of the building and be responsible for maintaining the entire facility. With our building issues behind us, FCMOA looks forward to a new and exciting future.

FCMOA served over 13,728 visitors in 2012 with an exhibition program that was one of the best in its history. Presentations of the work of Marc Chagall, David Wander, Liao Yibai, Ajean Ryan and Marlene Tseng-Yu were organized not only to delight the eyes, but engage the hearts and minds of our community. Our educational programming and partnership with Front Range Community College demonstrated the power of the visual arts to touch and influence students of all ages.

The museum's signature fundraiser, *Masks*, is returning to FCMOA in 2013 and we have already broken all previous sponsorship records through the hard work and dedication of our outstanding *Masks* committee, led by board member Myra Powers, and the loyal support of over 200 *Masks* artists and dozens of *Masks* sponsors.



In 2013, we will continue using the arts to expand and challenge our perceptions of the world. 2013 promises to be one of the most exciting years in our history. I hope you will join us for the adventure.

## Accomplishments

### **Program Highlights**

- *Chibuly Venetians: From the George R. Stroemple Collection and Colorado Collects Glass* was attended by over 9000 visitors.
- 250 people attended the Weekend of Fire program that featured lectures by nationally-renowned art scholars, glass making demonstrations and tours of the *Chibuly Venetians* and *Colorado Collects Glass* exhibitions.
- *Shapes of Art* Fundraiser and Gala raised over \$50,000 for FCMOA education and exhibition programs.
- *Marc Chagall Etchings from the Bible Series* represented the collaboration between FCMOA and the Singer Gallery in Denver to organize the exhibition and produce a full-color catalogue with an essay by internationally-recognized art historian Matthew Baigell.
- FCMOA presented its first AARP free day that was attended by over 100 members of AARP.
- *Structures in Cloth* exhibition was attended by over 1000 visitors who were able to view and learn about the fine art of quilting.
- The relationship between art and the environment was explored in an exhibition of the work of New-York based artist Marlene Tseng-Yu.

### **Institutional Highlights**

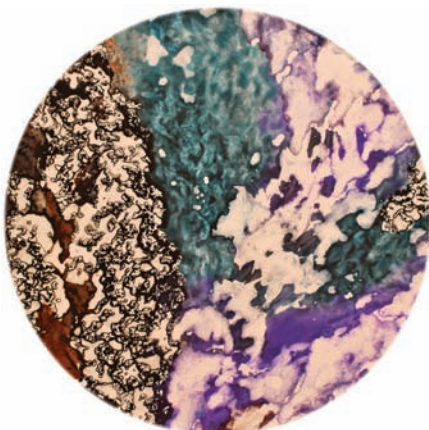
- FCMOA sells all but the first floor of its building to Brinkman Partners on August 9, 2012
